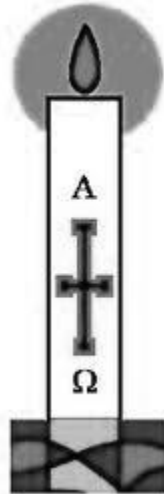

Season of Easter

The celebration of the Easter Vigil is the beginning of the season of Easter. It is the beginning of a new season of grace and a time of joy and thanksgiving, for Easter is not one day or one solemnity—it is a fifty day celebration, and the fifty days from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday together comprise what the General Instruction terms "the great Sunday".



The Easter candle, Paschal Candle, is placed in a prominent place in the sanctuary between Easter and Pentecost and is lighted for all liturgical services in this season.

The color of the vesture for the season is white, reflecting the season of new life, fulfillment, rejoicing and joy.

Parish Finance Committee

Canon 537 of the revised Code requires a finance council in each parish, subject to special norms established by the diocesan Bishop and composed of members of the parish selected according to those norms. The task of the finance council is to assist the pastor in administration of the property and finances of the parish. The importance of an active, informed council cannot be overemphasized. The active informed council would hold to the mission of the parish, protect the integrity of pastoral objectives, establish adequate council policies and ensure consistent adherence to those policies.

The Council is an advisory body and does not substitute for the pastor as the chief administrator and legal representative of parish matters. The relationship between the pastor and the Council is one of support and collaboration. The establishment of the Parish Finance Council does not lessen the authority of the pastor to act and decide on behalf of the parish as defined by Canon Law.

The Bishop of the Diocese of Tucson has established the following norms regarding the Parish Finance Council:

- The Council shall be composed of at least 3 members in addition to the Pastor and bookkeeper;
- Membership in the Council shall be diverse and include men, women and various occupations with financial expertise;
- The 3 additional members shall not be parish employees or serve in a volunteer function that affects their ability to make impartial and objective recommendations;
- The Council shall meet at least quarterly;
- The Council shall maintain written minutes of meetings;

- The Council shall review the annual operating budget and a separate capital improvement budget, if necessary, for the parish. The budgets are then submitted for approval by the Parish Board.
- The Council shall review the Parish Annual Financial Report and present it to the parish board for approval.
- The Council shall review the annual Financial Report to the Faithful.

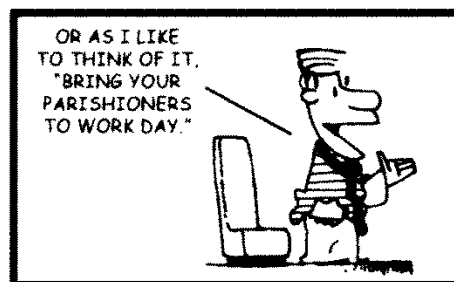

Sacramental Policies

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

At the 8:30am Mass on the first Friday of each month.

BAPTISM

Parents should contact the office, provide a copy of the child's birth certificate and participate in the class, to be offered monthly. Godparents must be practicing Catholics who are confirmed. Baptisms are scheduled in consultation between the family and the pastor. Please contact the pastor to make arrangements.

CONFESSION

One-half hour before all Masses, or by appointment.

CONFIRMATION

Only high school students will be admitted to the Confirmation Program. Youth are required to participate in CCD during both the 9th and 10th grades, and also participate in a special series of 6 classes for confirmation. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who are already confirmed. Parents should not be sponsors for their own children.

For information on Confirmation preparation for adults, please contact the Pastor.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

Offered to students in Grade 3. Children must attend CCD regularly throughout Grade 2 in order to be eligible to enter the sacramental preparation program in Grade 3. Students will also be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Grade 3

MARRIAGE

Both parties are expected to participate in the preparation program. Parties must notify the pastor at least one year prior to their proposed marriage date. Please meet with the Pastor for a fuller explanation of and to make arrangements.
