No Ordinary Time

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever. — Hebrews 13:8

The Church is now entering Ordinary Time and by ordinary we don't mean mundane. In Latin, Ordinary Time is called Tempus Per Annum ("time throughout the year"). It refers to that time in the Liturgical Year that is ordered or numbered. Ordinary Time falls in two segments; the time between the Monday after the Baptism of the Lord and Ash Wednesday, and the time between Pentecost and the first Sunday of Advent.

Ordinary Time is not a break or rest time in the Liturgical Year. There are many liturgical celebrations that fall during Ordinary Time – Trinity, Corpus Christi, All Saints, The Assumption of Mary and Christ the King. The Church also celebrates Saints days and other events during Ordinary Time.



Sacramental Policies

Anointing of the Sick:

At the 8:30 AM Mass on the first Friday of each month.

Baptism:

Parents should contact the office, provide a copy of the child's birth certificate and participate in the class, to be offered monthly. Godparents must be practicing Catholics who are confirmed. Baptisms are scheduled in consultation between the family and the pastor. Please contact the pastor to make arrangements.

Confession:

One-half hour before all Masses, or by appointment.

Confirmation:

Only high school students will be admitted to the Confirmation Program. Youth are required to participate in CCD during both the 9th and 10th grades, and also participate in a special series of 6 classes for confirmation. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who are already confirmed. Parents should not be sponsors for their own children.

For information on Confirmation preparation for adults, please contact the Pastor.

First Holy Communion:

Is offered to students in Grade 3. Children must attend CCD regularly throughout Grade 2 in order to be eligible to enter the sacramental preparation program in Grade 3. Students will also be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Grade 3

Marriage:

Both parties are expected to participate in the preparation program. Parties must notify the pastor at least one year prior to their proposed marriage date. Please meet with the Pastor for a fuller explanation of and to make arrangements.
