## Permanent Deacon Program

The next 4 year program for potential deacon candidates will begin in September of 2012 and culminate in 2017. Information Sessions for those inquiring about the deacon program will be held during the month of October, 2012 mainly in the city of Tucson. In addition to the information session, the Bishop is asking that all inquirers attend two Discernment Sessions to help them determine their readiness for the application process.

Deacon Candidates should have sufficient academic ability to do theological study and to participate actively in the formation program. They should be men of sound character, demonstrating generosity and sensitivity to the needs of the poor. They should have a deep conviction about Catholic Social Teaching and the ways in which we live it out in our world today. They also need to be men of faith on the journey to holiness and be open to the four pillars of formation, namely, spiritual, human, intellectual and pastoral. Those who are married should be in a stable valid Catholic marriage. Their wives must consent to their participation in this program and should have an interest in participating in the formation their husbands will experience.

It is important to remember that deacons are ordained for the Diocese. While every effort would be made to assign a deacon to his parish, some deacons may serve in diocesan ministries or may be asked to serve in parishes where there is a greater need for their ministry.

Application packets will be given at the second discernment session to those who attended the information session, discernment sessions and have the permission of their pastor. For the Diocese of Tucson, the men applying must be between the ages of 35 and 65 at the time of Ordination.

## Sacramental Policies

### ANOINTING OF THE SICK

At the 8:30am Mass on the first Friday of each month.

### BAPTISM

Parents should contact the office, provide a copy of the child's birth certificate and participate in a class, to be scheduled as needed. Godparents must be practicing Catholics who are confirmed and married in the Church, if married. Baptisms are scheduled in consultation between the family and the pastor. Please contact the pastor to make arrangements.

### CONFESSION

Confessions are offered one-half hour before all Masses, or anytime upon request.

### CONFIRMATION

Confirmation will be given students in 8<sup>th</sup> grade or above. They must have completed the 8<sup>th</sup> grade religious education class and optimally the 7<sup>th</sup> as well. Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who are already confirmed and married in the Church, if married. Parents should not be sponsors for their own children. For information on Confirmation preparation for adults please contact the pastor.

### FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

First Holy Communion will be offered to children in Grade 2. Children must attend CCD regularly throughout Grade 2 in order to receive the Sacrament in May of that year. Students will also be prepared for the Sacrament of Reconciliation in Grade 2.

### MARRIAGE

Both parties are expected to participate in the preparation program. Parties must notify the pastor at least one year prior to their proposed marriage date. Please meet with the Pastor for a fuller explanation of and to make arrangements.
